



Project Name: Cardinal Wuerl North Catholic High School

Project Location: Cranberry Township, PA

Project Overview

The 185,000 sq. ft. Cardinal Wuerl North Catholic High School consisted of a combined Division 6 and Division 12 package. The new school will house students from ninth to twelfth grade and will incorporate the STEM curriculum. The diocese used the Integrative Project Delivery method to choose its contractors. The school obtained LEED Silver certification through the use of sustainable and energy efficient elements. CiF utilized rapidly renewable materials to provide premium wood cabinetry that offers LEED status. Partners NEIS provided project installation and Artisan Millwork provided the custom millwork solution.
