The distinctive casework installation at the Yale School of Medicine, is highlighted by the peninsula bench end-cabinets incorporating stainless steel support posts. The peninsulas also incorporate removable divider panels at the write-up areas to accommodate additional researchers and maintain a separation for privacy. These benches were specifically designed to allow for the maximum amount of natural light to enter from the windows. The project also includes CiF custom sink cabinets, custom epoxy resin sink tops and custom drying racks to meet the specific needs of the client.
