The City of Kansas City East Patrol Crime Lab project consists of the four buildings on a stretch of property covering a total 135,000 square-feet. The two story crime lab covers 65,000 square-feet and will house building/technical support, a chemistry lab, a crime scene lab, a DEA lab, and an evidence lab. The crime lab was designed with input from officers to improve their efficiency and comfort.
